AT VERACRUZ

DECEMBER 11 THREE PM, PUERTO MEXICO IS THE PORT FOR
WHICH THE EIGHTEENTH OF MARCH THE MEXICAN TANKER MENTIONED
PREVIOUSLY CLEARED, THE TANKER HIGH IN THE WATER SHE APPEARED
TO BE ON AN EAST SOUTHEAST COURSE WHICH WOULD KEEP HER WELL TO THE
NORTHEAST OF THE COLUMBUS, THE TANKER WAS FOLLOWED BY THE
DESTROYER WHICH HAD BEEN PATROLLING OFF THE HARBOR SIGNED COCHRAN
