1. This is to advise that on the evening of
October 20, 1944 the subject named seaman fell into an
empty hold and sustained a badly fractures right elbow.

The accident occurred while he was running
to his gun station in answer to the warning of sirens
and shore batteries that enemy planes were approaching.

He was promptly removed to the 80th General
Hospital (US Army), Marseilles. Doctors verbal report
indicates possible future surgery and two months hos-
pitalization.
