 1. No defects in 3"/50 platform, however, the holding down bolts were found loose. These were secured and gun now trains satisfactorily.
 2. Installed.
 3. As WSA approves this item on new construction only, no change was effected.
 4. Both lights repaired.
 5. Not responsibility of Port Director.
 6. Steam line cannot be removed as it is an integral part of the standard EC-2 type vessel construction. Magazines are fully insulated and equipped with adequate blowers. No change was effected.
