- (d) Resume of voyage: Entire voyage without inci-
dent. Av. speed 13.9 knots. Navigation
lights at full brilliance.
- (e) No unusual delays in port.
- (f) Commerical radio operators appeared to carry
out wartime radio instructions for U.S. mer-
chant vessels.
- (g) No supplies needed.
- (h) The Master and Officers of the ship properly
carried out "Wartime Instructions for U.S.
Merchant Vessels".
- (i) No recommendations tending to the improvement
of the service.
- (j) No improper procedure on the part of friendly
aircraft approaching the ship was noted.
