 - (b) Port of Departure: Singapore, Malay States;
Date 4 November 1945; travelled singly, no escorts. Port of arrival, Abadan, Iran;
Date: 15 November 1945
 - (c) Contact with enemy: none
 - (d) Resume of voyage: entire voyage without incident. Average speed: 15.5 Navigation lights at full brilliance.
 - (e) No undue delays in port
 - (f) Commercial radio operators appeared to carry out wartime radio instructions for U.S. Merchant ships.
 - (g) No supplies needed
 - (h) The Master and Officers of the ship properly carried out "Wartime Instructions for U.S. Merchant Vessels", where applicable.
 - (i) No recommendations tending to the improvement of the service.
 - (j) No improper procedure on the part of friendly aircraft approaching the ship was noted.
