lights at full brilliance.
- (e) No unusual delays in port
- (f) Commercial radio operators appeared to carry
out wartime radio instructions for U.S. Mer-
chant vessels.
- (g) No supplies needed
- (h) The Master and Officers of the ship properly car-
ried out "Wartime Instructions for U.S. Merchant
Vessels".
- (i) No recommendations tending to the improvement of
the service.
- (j) No improper procedure on the part of friendly
aircraft approaching the ship was noted.
