The Coast Guard has received information alleging an apparent non-compliance with routing instructions by Robert Fulton Fox, Master of SS ABRAHAM CLARK. Circumstances surrounding the arrival of this vessel at Santos recently, indicate that the Master failed to follow routing instructions and thereby jeopardized the safety of his vessel and the ship's company.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
