1. SUBJECT, William Lawrence NUTTER, aboard the ACADIA as a mental patient who unsuccessfully tried to commit suicide by slashing his wrists, while in custody of a medical attendant reported to the boarding officer and surrendered Enclosures (A) and (B). (Enclosure (B) is SUBJECT'S Seaman's Certificate of Identification Z-369079.)

2. Enclosure (A) revoked and took custody of SUBJECT'S Certificate of Service #E402843. In accordance with the Hearing Officer's statement placed on Enclosure (A) the boarding officer endorsed SUBJECT'S white copy and returned it to SUBJECT while aboard the ACADIA.

3. SUBJECT stated that the Hearing Officer in Italy advised SUBJECT to surrender Enclosure (B) to the Coast Guard boarding officer in the United States.

4. Representatives of Immigration and FBI boarding the ACADIA are cognizant.
