TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-6219

Approving the Sale Alien and Documentation
Under Turkish Registry and Flag of the
Undocumented St. Sc. ACONCAGUA

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on August 14, 1947, authorized the sale of its undocumented steam screw ACONCAGUA, to the Republic of Turkey, represented by the General Administration of the State Seaways and Harbours of Turkey, with the privilege of documenting said vessel under foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 16th day of April 1948, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the undocumented steam screw ACONCAGUA, to an alien as above set forth, with documentation under Turkish registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
