Modification of Approval of the Transfer to Foreign Registry and Flag of the Oil Screw ALBATROSS

WHEREAS, By its Transfer Order No. C-5301, dated April 14, 1947, the Maritime Commission approved, pursuant to Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), the transfer of the oil screw ALBATROSS, Official No. 244549 by William M. Pond, Coral Gables, Florida, to Panamaian registry and flag; and

WHEREAS, A request has been received for a modification of the above, so as to approve the sale of said vessel to Mr. Manuel Vazquez Cortizo, a Cuban citizen residing in Havana, Cuba, and the transfer of said vessel to Cuban registry and flag in lieu of Panamaian registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 16th day of July 1947, that Transfer Order No. C-5301, dated April 14, 1947, be, and it is hereby modified so as to approve the sale of the oil screw ALBATROSS, Official No. 244549 to an alien, as above set forth, with transfer to Cuban registry and flag in lieu of Panamaian registry and flag, all other terms and conditions of the Commission's Transfer Order No. C-5301 to remain unchanged.
