Approving the Charter to an Alien of the Tanker ALBERT G. BROWN

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Bernuth, Lembcke Co., Inc., New York, N.Y., for the Commission's approval, pursuant to Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the voyage charter of the tanker ALBERT G. BROWN, Official No. 244531, to Glaban Lobo Co. S. A., Havana, Cuba, for one voyage with cargo of molasses from a port or ports in Cuba to a United States Gulf port or ports, loading to commence on or about March 6, 1948:

IT IS ORDERED, This 16th day of February 1948, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the voyage charter of the tanker ALBERT G. BROWN, Official No. 244531, to an alien for one voyage with a cargo of molasses, commencing on or about March 6, 1948, be, and it is hereby granted upon the condition that said vessel shall not be sub-chartered to aliens except as provided in General Order #59, as amended.
