MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION

The Coast Guard has received from a reliable source the following information concerning crew members of the SS ALBERT P. RYDER.

Report alleges that Dewey Inman, chief cook, has had in his possession during the current voyage of the RYDER medicine and narcotics for the purpose of sale. It is also alleged that Thomas J. Taylor, chief steward, has been an accomplice in the misconduct.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
