

WRECKAGE, Sighting of                      CONFIDENTIAL                      5ND

"ALCOA PIONEER", American freighter, (Andrew Gavin, master) reports sighting fresh oil drums, wreckage, lumber and oil slick 1800 June 13, 1942, at 3616 N. 6849 W. No survivors were found.

The same wreckage also is reported by "LIBERTY GLOW", American SS (H. Q. Foss, master) which sighted it at 0100 June 14.

NOTE: 5ND charts show an Axis submarine has been patrolling these waters for several days.
