TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5287

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Argentine Registry and Flag of the
S/S ALCOA VOYAGER

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Alcoa Steamship Company, Inc., New York, N. Y., for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended, (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the steam screw ALCOA VOYAGER (ex-WAUKAU), Official No. 218019, to Juan Barzacos, Nicolas Luran, Xenofon Francisco Luran and Demetrio Dandolo, all citizens of Argentina, residing in Buenos Aires, Argentina, with transfer to Argentine registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 4th day of April 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw ALCOA VOYAGER (ex-WAUKAU), Official No. 218019, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Argentine registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
