MERCADO sailed from New York aboard the SS "KING WOOLSEY" and signed off at Leghorn, Italy on 22 December, 1944. SUBJECT reported to the Army Hospital and was discharged at 1100, 28 December, 1944. Forms Ncg-2515 and Navcg-2765 are forwarded herewith.
- (b) ACAMPORA, Ferdindo, Z-496541; U.S. Passport # 196771, signed on SUBJECT vessel at Naples, Italy on 27 February, 1945. ACAMPORA sailed from New York aboard the SS "GEORGE H. THOMAS" and was admitted to the hospital at Naples, Italy on 25 January, 1945. Forms Ncg-2515 and Navcg-2765 are forwarded herewith.
