MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

In May, 1943, the Coast Guard was informed by a reliable source that Patrick Burke, A.B., serving on the SS ALEXANDER RAMSEY, was tried at Dakar by Special Army Court and convicted on the charge of being absent without leave in port, abusive language to the captain, being drunk and disorderly, and shirking duty. Burke was sentenced to six months, and fined.

Any further action which may be indicated will be taken by the Coast Guard in this case.
