*The M/S ALF LINDEBERG (Norwegian) arrived in the Port of Philadelphia on 13 August, 1945 and was boarded the same date for the purpose of interrogating her crew members. Leif EJOHNEROD, First Officer, was interviewed and he stated that the vessel departed Tromsø, Utsire on 23 July, 1945. He added that, to the best of his knowledge, all her crew members were bona fide seamen and possessed proper identity documents.*

ITINERARY: ARRIVED CHARLESTON, S. C. 3-30-45 FROM CRISTOBAL

*Interviews with the crew members of the M/S ALF LINDEBERG indicated that they are all bona fide seamen. The Immigration and Naturalization Service granted the crew permission to land.*
