Subj: M/S ALF LINDBERG (Norwegian) - Boarding Report

1. The M/S ALF LINDBERG (Norwegian) arrived in the Port of Philadelphia on 13 August, 1945 and was boarded the same date for the purpose of interrogating her crew members. Leif KJONNEROD, First Officer, was interviewed and he stated that the vessel departed Piraeus, Greece on 28 July, 1945. He added that, to the best of his knowledge, all her crew members were bona fide seamen and possessed proper identity documents.

2. Examination of the identity documents of, and interviews with the crew members of the M/S ALF LINDBERG indicated that they are all bona fide merchant seamen. The Immigration and Naturalization Service granted the entire crew permission to land.
