1. Willie KOENNECKE, Z-101939, COTP card 08109155, born in Germany 16 February 1893, Naturalized June 1937, # 4212722; deck engineer.
2. SUBJECT was checked through the files of another Government agency with the following results; SUBJECT is listed in the M.M.S.L. of 1 February 1944; reported in February 1942 to be pro-Nazi.
3. Interview with SUBJECT: he departed Germany in 1922, and has never returned; he has no relatives of any sort in Germany; married in 1943 to a U. S. citizen, native of New York; allegedly hates Hitler and all that Hitler has done to Germany; SUBJECT prefers never to speak German and declines to do so.
4. SUBJECT, deck engineer, has sailed on the ALGONQUIN for at least 10 years; he is well liked, respected, and found to be efficient and competent by the ship's present complement.
5. Clearance endorsement was placed on SUBJECT's maritime documents.
