TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5955

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Italian Registry and Flag of the
St. Sc. Tanker AMERICAN FISHER

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Crescent Towing & Salvage Company, Inc., New Orleans, La., for the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the steam screw tanker AMERICAN FISHER, Official No. 210617, to Ligure Societa di Navigazione a Responsabilita Limitata, Genoa, Italy, with transfer to Italian registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 4th day of February 1948, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the steam screw tanker AMERICAN FISHER, Official No. 210617, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Italian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
