to French Registry and Flag of the
S/S ANDREW CARNEGIE


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on August 1, 1946, authorized the sale of the S/S ANDREW CARNEGIE, Official No. 242277, to Republique Francaise, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 18th day of October 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the S/S ANDREW CARNEGIE, Official No. 242277, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to French registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
