"HELMEDACH, Henry Karl August - REF: (A) M.M.S.L. 1 SEPTEMBER, 1944, CD BK. #008926, 5'6", 170 LBS, FR. COMP., STOCKY, BL. EYES, BR. THIN HR., BORN GERMANY, 1888, 2ND ENGR. VAGABONDIA, S.T. KIDDOO. DANGEROUS PRO-NAZI SUSPECT WHO IS ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN ON THE GERMAN SUBMARINE THAT SANK THE LUSITANIA AND TO HAVE MANNED A MACHINE GUN SHOOTING AT THE SURVIVORS STRUGGLING IN THE WATER. SUBJECT IS VERY PRO-GERMAN, UNRELIABLE AND UNTRUSTWORTHY." SUBJECT man is identical. No action taken as SUBJECT man has U. S. Seaman's Passport #233578 issued 12 September, 1944, which date is subsequent to 1 September, 1944.
