Synopsis:

Ingvald Kr. EDDZ, Master of the Panamanian S/S ANEROLD, which was torpedoed October 2, 1942, off British Guiana, reported that SUBJECT is a troublemaker. The ship's articles show SUBJECT to be a native of Holland, thirty years of age, 6'l" tall, brown hair, fair complexion, and residing at 464 Avenue U, Brocklyn, N. Y. Captain EIDE stated that SUBJECT does not drink to excess and is capable of performing his duties, however, he was a close friend of John LEBBINK, (See Reference b) and assisted LEBBINK and Jorgen SEAUGEN, (See Reference a), in making exorbitant demands on the ship's officers, and in generally creating dissension amongst the crew. Captain EIDE feels that SUBJECT is a dangerous man who should be barred from shipping on Allied vessels.
