Synopsis: Ingvald Kr. BIDE, Master of the Panamanian S/S ANEROID, which was torpedoed October 2, 1942, off British Guiana, reported that SUBJECT is a trouble-maker. The ship's articles show that SUBJECT is a native of Holland, forty-seven years of age, 6'2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tall, has dark hair, fair complexion, and resides at 464 Avenue U, Brooklyn, N. Y. Captain BIDE advised that SUBJECT appears to be an intelligent man who does not drink and knows his job. This informant feels, however, that SUBJECT is a Nazi, but could give no reason for his opinion other than the fact that SUBJECT is a troublemaker, and does everything in his power to create dissension between the ship's officers and the crew. SUBJECT was one of the chief lieutenants of Jorgen SKAUGEN, (Subject of Reference a), and was a ringleader in obtaining a petition from the crew to the Master which demanded money and shore leave on threat of cessation of work in all departments, (See Enclosure A). SUBJECT was said to have obtained some of the signatures on threat of violence. Captain BIDE feels that SUBJECT is a dangerous man who will cause trouble on any Allied ship on which he sails.
