Confidential informant, reliability "A", reports that SUBJECT ship was torpedoed and sunk on 10/2/42. Informant reports that the crew aboard this ship was composed of Scandinavians, Dutch, Irish, English, and other nationalities, and was one of the worst he had ever seen; further that there was constant dissension between the officers and crew, and this feeling was largely fostered by Subjects of references (a), (b), (c), and (d). Informant further reports that on 9/22/42, while

the ship was in Port of Spain, Trinidad, B.W.I., a petition was presented, demanding money and shore leave under threat of discontinuance of work; informant explained that some of the crew was forced to sign the petition and others signed to avoid the displeasure of the ringleaders. The petition was signed by all but references (c) and (d).
