GARCIA on 554 holds Peru Maritime Book #486; Peruvian Military Registration Card #119987, documents issued to this person in Peru indicate he was born 25 December, 1905, in the Province of Tagna, Peru; this GARCIA stated through interpreter never lived in any U.S. city; sailed only on Norwegian, Danish and American vessels.  3. 180 lbs.; dark complexion, dark hair, no visible scars or marks; next-of-kin, Wife, Made P. De GARCIA - Vigil 550, Callao, Peru.
