THE NEW NOTE WAS SAID TO ASK FOR THE CREW'S RELEASE, CHARGING THAT

EXAMINATION PROVED THERE HAD BEEN NO SABOTAGE ABOARD THE ARAUCA

AND THEREFORE THE MEN WERE NOT LIABLE TO PROSECUTION.

IT ALSO NOTED THAT THE ARAUCA HAD SOUGHT REFUGE AT PORT EVERGLADES WHEN PURSUED BY A BRITISH SHIP WHICH, THE NOTE CHARGED, WAS ITSELF VIOLATING U.S. TERRITORIAL WATERS.
