The Coast Guard has received reliable information concerning crew trouble on the SS ARCHBISHOP MANY, during January, 1943 to May, 1943.

- 1. Kenneth E. Grant, A.B.;

 Walter James, O.S.;

 Maurice D. Hoover, O.S.;

 Richard R. Deacon, Utility man: have been reported as having missed ship.
- 2. Andrew J. Bolak, Ciler;
 Lawrence J. Ramos, Fireman: are reported as a source of trouble. No details presented.
- 3. Dale G. Garrigues. O.S., is reported to have missed ship and to have, further, upon a refusal of the Captain to re-sign him, knocked the Captain down and given him a beating.
- 4. Lewis S. Milkavich. 2nd Mate, is charged with coming aboard drunk from every port. Milkavich is also allegedly responsible for inciting trouble among the crew and arguing with officers.
- 5. John Thomasson, 1st Assit, Engineer, is reported to have incited trouble among the crew members and to have argued with officers.

Any necessary action in these cases will be taken by the Coast Guard.
