

31. M.S. ATLANTIC SUN
(See also Group 6; 11 February, 1943)

U.S. Tanker; built 1941; 11,355 gross tons; cargo, crude oil.
Departed Beaumont, Texas, 16 March, 1942, for Marcus Hook, Pa.
Torpedoed 21 March, 1942, 0245 EWT; off Beaufort Sea Buoy.
Weather, rainy; slight sea.
On board, 46; saved, 46.
Vessel: made port under own power.

This vessel received a torpedo hit forward on the starboard side. The Master took the ship in and anchored off Beaufort Sea Buoy, and later shifted to Lookout Bight, where temporary repairs were made. The ATLANTIC SUN left Lookout Bight on the morning of 3 April, and arrived at Marcus Hook 5 April, 1942.
