Consulate at Bombay has been informed by Criminal
Investigation Dept. of Bombay Police that the Master of
subject vessel took on board as a passenger, just prior
to departure from that port, a Greek national of
alleged pro-Axis sentiments, recently arrived in India
from Greece, who was under surveillance of local
