5. YOPP was checked through the files of the DIO, 6ND, with negative results.
6. Ship departed Savannah, Georgia, at 1310 - 13 July, 1944, but returned at 1405 - 13 July, 1944, due to condenser trouble. Repairs made, and ship departed Savannah, Georgia, at 0235 - 14 July, 1944.
