TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5612

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Norwegian Registry and Flag of the

St. Sc. AUGUSTINE HEARD

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on June 10, 1947, authorized the sale of its steam screw AUGUSTINE HEARD, Official No. 242630, to Sigurd Herlofson & Co. A/S, a private company organized under the laws of the Kingdom of Norway, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 16th day of July 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw AUGUSTINE HEARD, Official No. 242630, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Norwegian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
