GUNS: One 3" American gun, No. 596. Elevation, 30°; depression, 10°.

Arc of train, 120° to 240°.

AMMUNITION: 66 H.E. Shells.

SMALL ARMS: Two .303 cal. Hotchkiss machine guns.

AMMUNITION: 2300 rounds tita.

MAGAZINE: Magazine located aft on deck, not equipped for flooding.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Telephone from bridge to gun.

GUN CREWS: One Navy, ten ship's crew.

REMARKS: 6 smokefloats, 7 igniters, 25 steel helmets, Ship is degaussed.
