SOURCE OF COMPLAINT: Letter of 30 September, 1944 from Headquarters, File CG-628-BEACONOIL Comp. 8.

FACTS: The subject vessel was in New York at the time Headquarters' letter of 30 September was received but the vessel departed before action could be taken in regard to the report of oil pollution referred to in the subject file.

The shipping company has advised that the vessel is due to return to New York around the middle of November.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Up to the present time it has not been possible to take action in this case and it is recommended the file forwarded from Headquarters be retained at this office and the file be held open until the vessel returns to New York. It is further recommended that a copy of this report be forwarded to Headquarters for information.
