The British S/S BELLEROPHON was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: 1 - 4" Q.F. gun, mark IV Vickers 1918, No. 411, telescopic and open sights, (30° + 6°) elevation, arc of train 240°. Located after end, top of after deck house. 1 - 12-pounder Q.F. gun, mark B.S.O. 1915, No. 3050, open sights, (850 4 60) elevation, arc of train 3600. Located starboard side, forward end, top of after deck house, just forward and to starboard side of the " gun.

AMMUNITION: 40 - rounds H.E. shells; 10 practice shells; and 42 powder charges semi-fixed for the 4" gun. 40 - rounds H.E. shells; 12 practice shells; and 52

powder charges semi-fixed for the 12-pounder gun.

SMALL ARMS: 2 - Lewis machine guns .303 mounted midship on boat deck house. 2 - Ross rifles .303 and 2 Lee Enfield rifles .303. 1 Bayonet. AMMUNITION: 3532 - rounds .303

MAGAZINE LOCATION: Projectiles port side in after deck house. Powder charges in starboard side, after deck house.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Telephone from bridge to the guns. 1 Aldis daylight signalling lamp.

\*\*\* 4 service gas masks; 170 civilian gas masks.

GUNS CREWS: 2 - gun layers: 1 Royal Marines, and 1 Royal Navy. 2 merchant seamen gunners; rest of guns crews taken from regular ship's force. 4 certified

merchant navy defense officers.

REMARKS: 6 - smoke floats; 2 smoke float igniters; 20 steel helmets; 2 paravanes 1 Pain rocket projector and 4 rockets; 4 sets of decontamination equipment; 1 zigzag clock; 4 kites; 1 Holman projector; 1 convoy light; 2 convoy buoys; 47 bombs for Holman projector. 2 PAC projectors and 2 rockets. Cement slabs used around the bridge and radioroom for protection. (Hull degaussed) Wired. \*\*\*

It is the opinion of this office that the above-mentioned armament is carried for defensive purposes only, provided that this vessel is employed in normal trade.
