

REPORT OF ARMEMENT OF BELLIGERENT VESSEL *Aug*

Upon its arrival at Anacortes, Washington, on 30 December, 1940, the Norwegian Motorvessel BENJAMIN FRANKLIN was inspected by the Customs, Anacortes, and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: 1 - 4 inch gun with no ammunition

SMALL ARMS: 1 Colt machine gun with 1900 rounds
2 .30 cal. rifles with 500 rounds
4 pistols with 150 rounds.

It is believed that this vessel is armed for defense purposes only.
