MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Cladstone Dolphy, former steward on the SS CARDINAL GIBBONS and Walter Frederick Shivers, former A.B. on the SS BENJAMIN R. MILAM.

Report states Dolphy was involved in a fight aboard ship and refused to desist when ordered to his quarters. On charges evolved from this misconduct, the Coast Guard, at a hearing in Casablanca on 21 September, 1943, suspended Dolphy's certificate for 60 days.

It is reported that Shivers left his watch without being properly secured, failed to turn to when called and smoked at the wheel. On charges evolved out of this misconduct, the Coast Guard, at a hearing in October, 1943 in Casablanca, suspended Shivers' certificate for 60 days.
