Gentlemen:

As per instructions I am reporting the names and certificate numbers of the following men who were suspected of stealing personal articles of fellow crew members. Upon their discharge from this vessel these robberies ceased.

CORDEIRO, John V.	Z-10102 D1	2043 Colburn Ave., Honolulu
KIM, Soon Ku	Z-604191	1423 Emerson St., Honolulu
PHILLIPS, Edward	Z-110385	1022 Weaver Lane, Honolulu

These men were suspected of various robberies aboard this vessel between the dates of June 14th and July 1st. But the accusations could never be proven so that no direct action could be taken.

The Coast Huard Intelligence Division of San Pedro, California requested me to report to them or any other Coast Guard Agency if the robberies ceased upon the discharge of these men. If this proved to be correct they would then take action against these men.
