Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Panamaian Registry and Flag of the Steam Screw BESBORO

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Pillsbury & Martignoni, a co-partnership, with offices in San Francisco, California, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw BESBORO (ex-LURLINE BURNS), Official No. 217293, to Wallem & Company, a partnership consisting of Norwegian citizens, Hong Kong, China, with transfer of said vessel to Panamaian registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 3rd day of July 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw BESBORO (ex-LURLINE BURNS; ex-CADDOPEAKE), Official No. 217293, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Panamaian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
