1. The subject vessel is owned by Dubrovacka Plovidba of Dubrovnik, Yugoslavia and is registered at Dubrovnik, Yugoslavia. This vessel is under charter to the British Ministry of Shipping.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 10 June 1941 from Pernambuco, Brazil with 5300 tons of Chrome Ore. She entered this port to take on 180 tons of coal bunkers. The British Ministry of Shipping being a British Company the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
