1. The Yugoslav steamship BOSANKA arrived at this port from Turkey on 20 June, 1941. The vessel was inspected by members of this office. Crew members were interviewed and all seemed to be satisfied with present employment of vessel. There is no apparent dissention.

2. No reason is seen for withholding the departure permit for this vessel, and it is recommended that clearance be granted. She is due to proceed to Halifax and then go under British register.
