TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5470

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Italian Registry and Flag of the

Undocumented Tanker BOSTONIAN

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on May 2, 1947, authorized the sale of its undocumented tanker BOSTONIAN, (ex-ANTEO), to Societa' Ligure di Armamento, an Italian corporation, with offices in Genoa, Italy, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 9th day of May 1947, that the approval required by Section 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 835), of the sale of the undocumented tanker BOSTONIAN, (ex-ANTEO), to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Italian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of May 2, 1947.
