McCullough, 3rd Officer on the SS BRAZIL, violated postal security regulations recently by mailing with the ship's mail a letter which was found to contain information on the ship's movements, cargo and other confidential material.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action may be warranted in this case.
