Subject: Norwegian MS BRENAS, location and movements of.

Reference: (a) Los Angeles District ship movement report, dated 10 February, 1941.

1. It is noted in reference (a) that subject vessel arrived at Los Angeles, California, on 17 January, 1941, from Vancouver, British Columbia, and that she is still in port, however, her location is not reported.

2. Information received by Headquarters from another source indicates that a Norwegian vessel named BRENAS arrived at Havana, Cuba, from Los Angeles, California, on 6 February, 1941, and sailed therefrom on 7 February, 1941, for San Francisco, California.

3. In view of the fact that Lloyd's Register of Shipping lists only one vessel with this name, Headquarters desires information as to whether the BRENAS is now in port. In the event she is still in port, submit a detailed description of the vessel by dispatch.
