Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Mexican Registry and Flag of the Steam Screw CACALILAO

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by The Mexico Shipping and Trading Company, Inc., Wilmington, Delaware, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw CACALILAO (ex-DILLWYN), Official No. 219008 to Petroleos Mexicanos, Mexico City, Mexico, and the transfer of said vessel to Mexican registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 10th day of September, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw CACALILAO (ex-DILLWYN), Official No. 219008, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Mexican registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag, is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
