TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5433

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to French Registry and Flag of the

E/S Tanker CAMP DEFIANCE


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on March 28, 1947, authorized the sale of its electric screw Tanker CAMP DEFIANCE, Official No. 246539, to La Republique Francaise - Ministere Des Travaux Publics Et Des Transports (Secretariat General A La Marine Marchande), with offices at Paris, France, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 8th day of May, 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 803 and 835) of the sale of the electric screw Tanker CAMP DEFIANCE, Official No. 246539, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to French registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
