Subject shipped on SS FAIRLAND from New York, 16 Apr 43. He became involved in a fight in a cafe at Montevideo and missed the ship. He was placed in jail and remained there for 22 days. He was released to the American Consul. He returned to the U.S. on subject vessel as a workaway. He expects to re-ship.
