

REPORT OF ARMAMENT OF BELLIGERENT VESSEL


Upon its arrival at Seattle, Washington on 19 September, 1940, the British Motorvessel CAPE HORN was inspected by the Collector of Customs, Seattle, and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: 1 - 4" gun mounted on stern  
25 complete round and 2 practice shells for 4" gun

SMALL ARMS: 2 - 303 Lee Enfield rifles

AMMUNITION: 250 rounds of ammunition  
Ship fitted with degaussing apparatus and paravanes

It is believed that this ship is armed for defense purposes only.
