1 - 4" gun mounted on stern GUNS:

25 complete round and 2 practice shells for 4" gun

2 - 303 Lee Enfield rifles SMALL ARMS:

AMMUNITION: 250 rounds of ammunition

Ship fitted with degaussing apparatus and paravanes

It is believed that this ship is armed for defense purposes only.
