Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to British Registry and Flag of the

El. Sc. Tanker CHACO CANYON

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on August 13, 1947, authorized the sale of its electric screw Tanker CHACO CANYON, Official No. 246119, to The Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company, Limited, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 17th day of September, 1947, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the electric screw Tanker CHACO CANYON, Official No. 246119, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to British registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
